Note: if there is precipitation in the LT solution, heat the LT solution up to 40 °C until the precipitate dissolves.

Additional equipment and reagents

Necessary

- 1.5 ml, 2 ml sterile Eppendorf tubes
- Incubator or thermoblock set to 37 °C, 75 °C
- Vortex
- Microcentrifuge

Material preparation

Blood (fresh or frozen, up to 100 µl)

1. Transfer 100 µl of blood to a 1.5 ml Eppendorf tube (not included).

Note: for blood volume less than 100 $\mu l,$ add Tris buffer to a total volume of 100 $\mu l.$

2. Follow point 1. of the isolation protocol.

Blood (fresh or frozen, 200 µl-1 ml)

- Transfer the appropriate amount of blood to a 1.5 ml tube (not included). Add half of the volume of LE solution, e.g. add 250 µl of LE solution to 500 µl of blood.
- 2. Mix by inverting the tube until it becomes completely transparent.
- 3. Centrifuge for 3 min at 10 000-15 000 RPM.
- Discard the supernatant. Add 100 µl of Tris buffer to the pellet (leukocyte cells) and resuspend cells by pipetting.
- 5. Follow point 1. of the isolation protocol.

For a larger volume of blood samples we recommend Genomic Midi AX (cat. # 895-20) or Genomic Maxi AX (cat. # 995-10).

Isolation protocol

Set the thermoblock temperature to 75 °C and place in it the tubes with Tris elution buffer (it will be used in point 12. of the isolation protocol).

1.	Add 200 µl of LT lysis solution and 20 µl of Proteinase K .
2.	Mix the whole contents by inverting the tube and incubate for 20 min at 37 °C .
3.	Vortex the samples intensively for 20 s and apply samples onto the minicolumns.
4.	Centrifuge for 1 min at 10 000-15 000 RPM .
5.	Remove the minicolumns from the tubes. Discard the filtrates. Place the minicolumns into the same tubes.
6.	Add 500 μl of A1 wash solution.
7.	Centrifuge for 1 min at 10 000-15 000 RPM .
8.	Transfer the minicolumns to new 2 ml tubes (included).
9.	Add 400 μl of A1 wash solution.
10.	Centrifuge for 2 min at 10 000-15 000 RPM .
11.	Transfer the minicolumns to new 1 .5 ml tubes (not included).
12.	Add 100 μI or 200 μI of Tris buffer heated to 75 °C directly onto the minicolumn resin. Note: for 100 μ I blood volume add 100 μ I of Tris buffer; for larger volume add 200 μ I of Tris buffer.
13.	Incubate for 5 min at room temp.
14.	Centrifuge for 1 min at 10 000-15 000 RPM .
15.	Remove the minicolumns and store the tubes with purified DNA at 4 °C or -20 °C until later use
